**“Destitute Children Scholarships Program”** Even though the rate of school attendance is better than ever before with more and more children between the ages of 6 and 14 enrolling at schools, the education system is inadequately developed - wracked by a shortage of resources, schools, classrooms and teachers. Often, resulting in poor quality of teaching, poverty, illiteracy and ignorance of parents, many children drop out before completing five years of primary school and many of those who stay on, learn little. These drops out children are becoming prostitutes, juveniles, child labours. Some anti-social elements are exploiting these children and using them for their benefits. So to curb these exploitations and to improve the enrolling rate by decreasing the drop outs, Valmiki Foundation has been rendering remarkable services to the poor and needy students.
